【About Doctors' Picks】

Doctors' Picks is a medical practice/medical science news site where any doctors who are members of CareNet.com can select and share articles of interest and expand the network among doctors by posting comments. Its greatest feature is that experts of various fields (Expert Picker) carefully select and present (pick) important news in their fields and post comments about them as well. Therefore, doctors who are members can promptly find the latest important news selected in each field, and understand the main points of this news more profoundly.

Members can register (follow) doctors that they are interested in, to browse the news picked by these doctors as needed at the time, making it easier to find interesting news. In addition, a doctor who is a member can share news about medical practice/medical science on the Internet that the member considers important with other doctors and post comments.

These functions create mutual communication among doctors via comments on news of interest or focused-on news, expanding the network. The site is limited to doctors and should be used with the real name for safe and secure communication among doctors.

Doctors are very busy without enough time to collect information, and wish to collect useful information more conveniently. To meet this need, an iOS version application of

Doctors' Picks has been developed. The interface is optimized for iPhone, with additional features such as notifications of new posts through push notification, and easier operation to pick articles to further improve its convenience.

“Doctors' Picks” has been improved in its usability with the addition of the iOS version application, and we think it will further gather the latest and important specialty information, creating various communication networks among a number of doctors.
